

## **RIIA BYLAWS**

### **ARTICLE X**

#### **Amendments**

*Section 1.* The by-laws shall only be amended by a written ballot and must be carried by a two thirds (2/3rds) majority vote of the members who cast a vote in person, by mail or by proxy at any annual or special meeting called for that purpose.

No amendment to the by-laws shall be presented to the members for approval without written notice of the proposed change having been first given to all members in the manner prescribed in ARTICLE III, Section 4 of these by-laws. Said notice shall state, verbatim, the language of the existing by-law section as amended, with any changes therein being underlined. The ballots for the voting on the proposed by-laws change shall be in such form as prescribed by the Board of Trustees. One ballot shall be issued by the secretary for each member eligible to vote. The tallied vote shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.
